Interviewing



You are in the driver's seat – interviewees appreciate you gently and firmly keeping them on track so their time isn't wasted.



Ask about what they **did** not what they **would do**. Ask about **their behavior** and what led to it.



Avoid influencing what they say – be neutral.



Use **how/what/when/where/who** questions – NOT why or yes/no questions.



Don't give your thoughts or opinions during the interview.



If on a video call, **always have your camera on** (even if they don't).

STORY-BASED INTERVIEW

- One person asks questions
- One person takes detailed notes (share doc with interviewer)
- One person answers about their experience

- **Start with Tell me about... When was that?**
- **Ask about BEHAVIOUR and CIRCUMSTANCE before feelings**
- **Uncover emotions and identity**
